CHAP CLARK

(PHD, UNIVERSITY OF DENVER)

Chap is the professor of Youth, Family, and Culture at Fuller Theological Seminary, the senior editor of *YouthWorker Journal*, a *Sojourner* contributing writer and "Red Letter Communicator," and president of ParenTeen™ and HURT Seminars. He is a speaker, trainer, consultant, as well as the author of 17 books, including *Hurt: Inside the World of Today's Teenagers* and *Deep Ministry in a Shallow World*. Chap has served in many diverse settings over his career, in the church, parachurch, and industry and is highly acclaimed resource for the community in adult, youth, and family ministries.

DR LLOYD MCKAY

Lloyd McKay has spent more than 20 years as an economic policy analyst in developing countries around the globe. While employed by the Harvard Institute for Development and the World Bank, Lloyd worked closely with many officials in these countries and lived in several of them with his family. Examples of his work include advising Indonesia on debt management, helping prepare the first budget for East Timor, assisting the Philippine Supreme Court with its reform of the judiciary, and co-leading a team of experts prepare a post conflict reconstruction project for Somalia. Before embarking on this journey through the developing world, Lloyd completed a PhD in economics in Canada.

Lloyd has been actively involved in the church in each of the developing countries in which he lived, including numerous leadership roles. He is married and has three grown children.
